Area 78.866 km²




52% agriculture, 36 % forest, 2% water, 10% settlements



Population 10.870.000, 134 inh./ km² (2023)

4 national parks (1.5%), 26 protected landscape areas (13.6%), 41 special protected areas - SPAs (ca 9% of the area)






Altitudes in Czechia






Development of breeding population of WTE in CR














Imperial eagle population development in CZ 1997-2023















Breeding pairs of LSE in Czechia








Breeding pairs of Golden eagle in Czechia
