
Egypt located at the northeast corner of Africa and southwest corner of Asia by a land bridge formed by the Sinai Peninsula.

Introduction

This study aims to understand the ecology of aggregations of Steppe eagle (outside breeding range) at dumping sites along the narrow migration corridors of the flyway at Hurghada city located at Egyptian Red Sea coast during a time after the coast had been developed for tourism.


Results & Findings



- Some Steppe Eagle goes from the north of Africa through the middle and southern regions of Africa, including Hurghada, where they can find a suitable place to winter. In Hurghada they can find enough food at dumping sites, safe roosting area at Red Sea mountains and electric pylons and water near resorts on the Red Sea coast.
- •One eagle been tagged from Jourdan 2021 by Mick Mc Grady was wintering in 2021, 2022& 2023 in Hurghada City.




The migration and summering grounds of a Steppe eagle that wintered in Hurghada during winters of 2021-22 and 2022-23.




Aggregations of Steppe Eagles after Sunset



Movements of a Steppe eagle in Hurghada





Discussions

- •The tourism industry in Hurghada has been growing rapidly in recent years. In 2022, the city hosted over 13 million tourists, making it the second most popular tourist destination in Egypt after Sharm El Sheikh city.
- •The food waste from this numbers of tourist represent the main source of food for Those eagles wintering in Hurghada.
- •10000 individuals almost present 10% of the world populations.
- •Adult arrive first to the dumping site then Juvenile start to come from the middle of February.
- •Further study is need for more details and counting hours to get more information about movement of those endangered bird.
- •I did not continue my survey during 2023 due to Financial constraints and lack of my personal funds , As those previous survey is based one my personal funds.
